

The First 30 Days with the ReBuilder TENS and Conductive Garments

Medicare, and most Insurance plans require documentation on the use of the ReBuilder for the first thirty (30) days. Using the Treatment Record you received in your delivery, please note:

- how often you used the ReBuilder in the past 30+ days,
- for approximately how long
- how you were feeling when you started using the ReBuilder, and
- your improvement

Send a copy of the completed Treatment Record back to us at the end of the first 30 days. Keep a copy for your records, and take or send a copy to your doctor for your medical file.

Medicare and Medicare Advantage Plan Beneficiaries:

Medicare and the Medicare Advantage Plans **require** that you see your doctor 30 to 60 days (not less than 30 days) after you begin using your ReBuilder unit so your progress can be evaluated and documented.

Your doctor will document your use and improvement on the Certificate of Medical Necessity at your 30-Day appointment.

Your doctor will also need to document the medical necessity for both the ReBuilder TENS Unit and the Conductive Garments.

Please give your doctor the following included documents, and ask that the CMN be completed and faxed back to us at 304-725-4915:

1. Letter of Request from ReBuilder Medical Technologies, Inc.
2. BLANK Certificate of Medical Necessity that he can complete
3. SAMPLE Certificate of Medical Necessity
